Hometown Military Heroes Banner Guidelines for Participation

Description

The Hometown Military Heroes Banner project is a fundraiser for the Derby Veterans Memorial Endowment Fund and the Operational Endowment Fund. This project will span three years. Each year before Veteran's Day seventy-five banners will be placed along the K-15/Buckner corridor and remain up for one year. When the banner is retired, it will be returned to the purchaser. **The Derby Community Foundation and the City of Derby are not responsible for damage to or loss of banners that may occur while displayed on light poles.**

Criteria and Instructions

- 1. Persons who served or are serving honorably with the United States military may be honored with a banner.
- 2. A former US military member being honored must have been honorably discharged.
- 3. A current US military member being honored must be in good standing.
- 4. The banners will be in English and are limited to the honoree's full name, branch of service, military rank or grade, and conflict.
- 5. Only 225 banners are available for purchase.
- 6. A digital photo of the honoree will need to be uploaded and included with the order form. Military portraits are preferred.
 - a. Photos can be scanned and emailed to derby@communitygiving.org. A copy of the order form needs to accompany all pictures.
 - b. If you need help scanning your picture, contact the DCF at 316-788-9815 to arrange an appointment to come into the office and have your picture scanned. Payment and completed order forms should be brought to this appointment as well.
- 7. The cost to purchase a banner is \$200. Of this \$200, \$120 may be designated as a tax deduction according to IRS regulations governing 501(c)3 organizations.
- 8. Checks or money orders are payable to Derby Community Foundation (Hometown Military Heroes on the memo line) at PO Box 372, Derby, KS 67037. A copy of the order form needs to accompany all checks.
- 9. Payment with a credit or debit card can be completed through the Derby Veteran's Memorial Fund donation link on our website. If paying with a credit or debit card, please note in your email (see #6) that payment was made online.
- 10. Should the proposed wording not meet the above criteria, a representative of the Derby Community Foundation will contact the donor to discuss possible amendments.
- 11. Fully completed forms will be numbered in the order in which they are received. Donors will be notified by mail or email when the honoree's banner will be installed.
- 12. Only fully completed order forms with a photo and appropriate payment will receive a number and be included on the installation list.
- 13. If the banner is damaged or destroyed by an act of nature while hanging, a replacement banner may be purchased for \$200.
- 14. Ordering deadline is July 1 of the current year. Ordering will be discontinued if the maximum number of banners is reached before that deadline.
